Gerspacher manages police capacity building projects that help strengthen policing governance policies and practices, focusing on how to develop security institutions that are service oriented and legitimate in the eyes of the public. She has worked in North Africa and the Middle East and serves as an advisor on projects in various African countries. Gerspacher has done extensive research on community policing, international police cooperation and policing for countering violent extremism and has taught related courses both to police officers and in the university setting. She has also developed online courses for various audiences.

In addition, Gerspacher oversees several programs that prepare advisers to deploy on capacity building missions. She addresses both readiness and pre-deployment training for military and civilians preparing to serve as capacity builders, working in partnership with U.S. and European government agencies and organizations to diffuse the lessons learned and curriculum developed. She also oversees studies that help deploying agencies maximize the effectiveness of advisors and capacity building missions.


